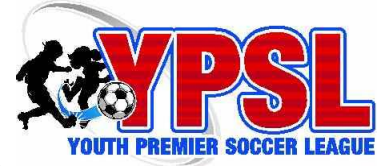

The Youth Premier Soccer League is a high quality regional league, providing top-level competition for elite players across the northeastern United States. Multiple games are played over competition weekends at central venues through the summer, which enables more playing opportunities per weekend. The league offers top quality soccer throughout the summer season, supporting player development within genuinely regional competition, while minimizing travel and accommodation costs (of which each individual player is responsible for). Through YPSL play, players are eligible to be selected to attend the national id2 camp.

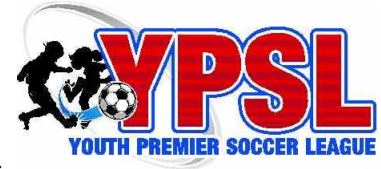

### COMMITMENT LETTER TRAINING & FEES

The New England Mutiny offers summer training designed to provide all players on every team the most competitive level of training and competition play possible. The commitment necessary for the team is a responsibility borne by both player and family, so upon accepting your position on the roster; it is important that everyone agrees to and understands the commitment being made to the team for the benefit of all the girls. It is necessary for such a commitment to be made by all team members in order to allow the team to continue to move forward and be challenged. This commitment is for an 8 week summer program.

1. When placed on the roster, each player commits to being at all games and training unless they are ill, injured or have a major and unavoidable family event etc. ODP play can be an exception.
2. While understanding that players will play multiple sports, which may create occasional conflicts, players recognize that the commitment to the team is two weekly training sessions through June – late July.

**Deposits to hold or accept a roster spot are non-refundable, as we offer a limited number of spots for any roster, and notify those not accepted immediately to enable them to make other summer soccer plans. We make financial commitments to run teams based on accepted roster spots and deposit payments, so refunding those deposits would leave us liable for considerable costs with no way of paying for them. Because of this, there can be no exceptions to this policy under any circumstances.**

Although the actual start date of the above identified summer select programs may vary, the scheduled start date for all summer teams is June 8th. For cancellations made once the program has begun (June 8<sup>th</sup>), no refunds will be issued under any circumstances. For cancellations made up to 60 days prior to the start of the program, and based on individual circumstances, credit may be carried forward to other programs, camps or clinics run by the New England Mutiny. Please note that there are no exceptions to this policy. In the event of tournaments being canceled due to the weather, we will attempt to schedule alternate game or training activities. In the event that the player is unable to attend these rescheduled activities, refunds will not be issued, but at the discretion of the New England Mutiny, credit may be given.
